What is Stonewall Youth?

Stonewall Youth is an organization for queer identifying youth who are 12 to 21 years old. Founded in 1991, Stonewall Youth is an organization of youth activists that empowers LGBTQ+ youth to speak for themselves, educate their communities, support each other, and work for social justice.

What are Fellowships?

Fellowships are a way for youth participants to get even more involved in Stonewall Youth. Fellowships offer a paid opportunity for youth to get job experience, get involved in a local non profit, and help support their peers and community. You might be ready for a fellowship if you can,

- Commit to roughly 3 hours/week of work for Stonewall Youth
- Work closely with Fellowship Staff to help see your project through
- Have availability all or most of Stonewall Youth's open hours (Wed 4-7pm Thur 5-7pm)
- Are self-motivated
- Able to meet deadlines

Currently there are 3 tracks available for fellowships. Workshops/ Education, Outreach, and Self-Made Project. You may choose one of these tracks to focus your fellowship on.

Applications are limited to two (2) youth per quarter, on a first come first serve basis. Only youth participants of our weekly Drop-Ins are eligible for quarterly Fellowships.

<u>Payment</u>

Stonewall Youth pays our fellows **monthly stipends of \$160**. If fellowships start and/or end in the middle of the month we prorate stipend payment. Payments happen at the end of the month after evaluating work completed. If work has not been completed on time, it may be withheld until new deadlines are set and followed through on.

Workshop/Education

Throughout the quarter fellows pursuing our workshop/education track will be responsible for **creating programming that helps to educate, inform, and engage their peers in topics and issues related to LGBTQ youth**. This track might be ideal for you if you enjoy or want to learn public speaking, how to put together a workshop, or have an interest in history and social justice. No previous experience required.

Outreach

Throughout the quarter fellows pursuing our outreach track will be responsible for assisting in **flyering**, **tabling, and getting more of their peers engaged in Stonewall Youth programs**. This track might be ideal for you if you enjoy or want to learn how to network with community orgs and members, educate others about what Stonewall Youth's offers, and/or learn how to promote events. No previous experience required.

Self Made Project

Throughout the quarter fellows pursuing our self-made project track will be responsible for **making a project that can be performed or presented to fellow youth participants**. This track might be ideal for you if you enjoy or want to learn how to take a project from an idea to a reality and/or create something not outlined in the other tracks available.
